(B) EXPORT PROMOTION OF CAPITAL GOODS (EPCG)ON "O" CUSTOM DUTY BASIS FOR THE MACHINERY USED IN THE FACTORY FOR EXPORT PRODUCT TO EARN FOREX FOR THE COUNTRY.

(C) ADVANCE LICENCE WITHOUT ANY DUTY OF THE CUSTOM i.e INPUT AND RAW MATERIALS USED FOR THE EXPORT PRODUCT .

(D) ONE STAR, TWO STAR ,THREE STAR,FOUR STAR AND FIVE STAR STATUS HOUSE CERTIFICATE HOLDERS WILL AVAIL the EXCELLENT benefit of CUSTOM CLEARANCE FOR BOTH IMPORT AND EXPORTS ON SELF-DECLARATION BASIS,EXEMPTION FROM FURNISHING OF BANK GUARANTEE,EXEMPTION FROM COMPULSORY NEGOTIATION OF DOCUMENTS THROUGH BANK REMITTANCE/RECEIPTS AND OTHER MANY INCENTIVES.
